



Dear Racing Fan:

The NYRA's Saratoga Reserved Seat drawing for 2007 will conclude on November 24<sup>th</sup>, 2006. **All applications MUST be *postmarked* by November 24<sup>th</sup>, 2006 to be eligible.** Any request postmarked after November 24<sup>th</sup>, 2006, will be processed in the order each was received by the Reserved Seat Office *after the original drawing is completed.*

The total capacity of our single tiered seating structure is about 6,600 seats. There are 2,300 Clubhouse seats and 4,300 Grandstand seats. Approximately 1,525 of our Clubhouse seats are used by the Advanced Reservation Program and approximately 240 Clubhouse seats are used by the Clubhouse VIP Program. Less than 500 Clubhouse seats are available to the Category 'I' applicants.

The NYRA will divide and process the applications into THREE categories in the following order of preference:

Category 'I' and 'II' requests **MUST** be for the same number of seats for each racing day and **MUST** be for the same location.

- 1) Category 'I' seat requests for every day of the meeting (July 25 through September 3 (36 days))
- 2) Category 'II' seat requests for complete week(s) only (minimum of six consecutive racing days, all segments **MUST** be a minimum of six consecutive racing days)
- 3) Category 'III' all other requests

***Depositing your check does NOT GUARANTEE Saratoga seating.  
The NYRA requires at least twenty days for your check to clear.***

***If you do not receive seating, the NYRA will return your funds.***

We will NOT mail any invoices or tickets *until at least twenty days after your check was deposited to permit your check to clear.* If money needs to be returned to you, any invoices, tickets or checks will NOT be mailed until our return check is processed by our Accounting Department and at least twenty days have passed since your check was deposited. The NYRA requires at least twenty days for your check to clear.

**DRESS CODE**

**Clubhouse**

Proper attire required at Management's discretion.  
No abbreviated wear (i.e. short-shorts, cut offs, midriff tops, etc.).  
Gentlemen: No tank tops.

**Grandstand**

Shoes and shirts required at all times.
